Abstract:

This is the second year that a school-based assessment component has been included in the HKCE English Language Examination. To ensure fairness, the scores submitted by teachers are moderated before they are included in the subject total. The SBA Moderation Report is sent to schools to give teachers feedback about the SBA scores submitted.

In this session, speakers from the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) will present the moderation results for the 2008 HKCE English Language Examination and discuss the positive impact of the SBA on the teaching and learning of English in secondary schools in Hong Kong.
