




SBA in the HKCEE English Language 2007: Results and Reflection

Abstract:

This is the first year that the school-based assessment component has been included in the HKCE English Language Examination. To ensure fairness, the scores submitted by teachers are moderated statistically before they are included in the subject total. The SBA Moderation Report is sent to schools to give teachers feedback about the SBA scores submitted.

In this session, speakers from the HKEAA will talk about the method of statistical moderation and the information provided in the Moderation Report, present the overall results of statistical moderation, and review the SBA programme for the 2007 cohort with a view to shedding light on the positive washback of the SBA on the teaching and learning of English in secondary schools in Hong Kong.
